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About this report

This report on the conduct of the 2021 NSW Local Government elections is presented in two parts.

Part one provides an overview of the elections conducted by the NSW Electoral Commissioner on Saturday, 4 December 2021. It includes changes to the Acts that govern the conduct of local government elections, aggregated statistical information about the elections, information about voting methods, venues, Election day staffing and how the election was funded.


Part one also summarises the integrity and enforcement activities of the Electoral Commission in relation to the conduct of participants in the Local Government elections. This work includes the registration of candidates, groups, and third-party campaigners for campaign finance regulation purposes; compliance operations undertaken during the elections; investigating allegations of breaches of electoral law; and legal proceedings commenced in relation to the elections.

Part one also includes recommendations by the Electoral Commissioner for legislative reform arising from his experience in conducting the election.

Part two provides information about each individual local council election, including candidates, results, breakdown of formal votes cast by vote type, election day staffing and venues.

Costs invoiced to councils do not reflect the total cost of running the elections. See the *Funding and financial management* section in Part 1 for information about the funding components of the 2021 NSW Local Government elections.


















