Who should complete this form

The information on this form is collected under, and provided by you, in compliance with the Lobbying of Government Officials Act 2011 and the Lobbying of Government Officials (Lobbyist Code of Conduct) Regulation 2014.

A person who provides information to the NSW Electoral Commission knowing that the information is false or misleading in a material particular is guilty of an offence. The maximum penalty is \$22,000 or 24 months imprisonment or both.
