Over the past few decades I have seen Cabramatta slowly shake it's reputation as an ethnic enclave. I am proud to say I come from Cabramatta. Cabramatta has a strong and continuing community identity and has a long history of 40 years as an electorate. It is the home town of former Prime Minister Gough Whitlam, and is a major commercial centre. It has represented the community well, and there is a close affinity within the community and geographical surrounds. If you live in Fairfield, Canley Vale, Lansvale, Carramar or Villawood people will say you come from Cabramatta. The name of the electorate should be the one people will recognise.
