

Kempsey Shire Council election Saturday, 30 July 2022

Enrol to vote

An election will be held for Kempsey Shire Council on Saturday, 30 July 2022 to fill eight councillor positions.

Residential roll

If you are enrolled in the in the Kempsey Shire Council area as at **6pm Monday**, **20 June 2022** you must vote.

To update your enrolment details online or to obtain a residential enrolment form visit <u>aec.gov.au</u> or call 13 23 26. Enrolment forms must be received by **6pm Monday**, **20 June 2022**.

Voting in Local Government elections is compulsory for all electors included on the residential roll.

Non-residential rolls

If you are an owner, rate-paying lessee, or occupier of rateable land which is not your primary residence, you or a nominee may be entitled to be enrolled on the roll of non-residential owners of rateable land or the roll of occupiers and rate-paying lessees for this election.

Details of the eligibility criteria and enrolment claim forms may be obtained from the Kempsey Shire Council through their website: <u>https://www.kempsey.nsw.gov.au/Residents/Customer-Service/Find-a-form</u>

The claim must be completed and lodged with Kempsey Shire Council by 6pm Monday, 20 June 2022.

If you were previously included on a non-residential roll you may want to confirm with the Council that your details are correct.
